








# How to Sort and Dispose of Household Waste

Please follow the rules for waste disposal!

## (1) Sort your garbage and place it in separate garbage bags.

### Bind recyclable paper with string instead.

Please use only colorless transparent or white semitransparent plastic bags to dispose of your garbage.

Garbage types	Examples
Burnable waste	Kitchen scraps, tissue paper and other paper scraps, plastic products, etc. 
Nonburnable waste	Glass (other than bottles), dishware, pots, small electric appliances, etc. 
Glass bottles & cans	Empty cans and glass bottles that contained food, drinks, etc. 
Plastic (PET) bottles	Empty plastic (marked as PET) bottles that contained water, liquor, seasonings, etc. 
Plastic containers & packaging	Snack bags, meal containers, shampoo/detergent containers, etc. 
Textiles	Clothing, towels, blankets, etc. 
Recyclable paper	Newspapers, cardboard, paper cartons, miscellaneous recyclable paper (empty snack boxes, magazines, etc.) 

**(2) Check the disposal day for each type of garbage.**

Each type of garbage can be disposed of only on the designated days. Garbage put out on the wrong day will not be collected. Refer to the garbage collection schedule for details.

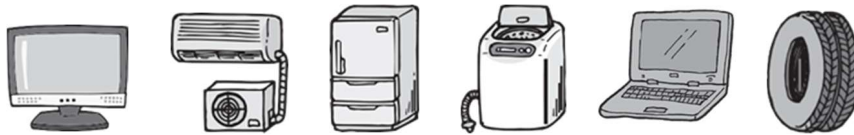
**(3) Put your garbage in the collection area by 8 a.m.**

Garbage may not be put out on the day before, or after collection.

**(4) Large waste may not be put out in garbage collection areas.**

Please refrain from disposing of waste items measuring over 50 cm (furniture, large electric appliances, etc.) in the garbage collection areas. For information on how to dispose of large waste, call the Resource Recycling Promotion Division at 049-239-6267.

**(5) The following household waste items are NOT collected by the city.**



Televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners, computers, car parts, etc.

**(6) Business/commercial waste may NOT be disposed of in garbage collection areas.**
